WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE
EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 7, 2009

AFFECTED AREAS: THE AREA BETWEEN SHERATON KEAUHOU RESORT TO OLD KONA AIRPORT PARK (INCLUDES QUEEN KA'AHUMANU HIGHWAY, KUAKINI HIGHWAY, ALI'I DRIVE, AND KING KAMEHAMEHA III ROAD); NORTH KONA, HAWAII

Due to a planned Hawai'i Electric Light Co., Inc., power shut-off at our Kahalu'u Shaft to replace a transformer, the Department of Water Supply urges consumers in the Affected Areas to conserve water on **Wednesday, October 7, 2009, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** During this power shut-off, the Department of Water Supply will not be able to pump water from the Kahalu'u Shaft to replenish the water tanks. Water Conservation during this time should ensure that everyone will have water. Water Conservation Notice is a voluntary action to reduce water usage by 10%.

For customers in the Affected Areas of the Water Conservation Notice, a list of ways to reach the 10% reduction goal is provided:

- Wash only full loads of laundry or dishes at a time.
- Check faucets and pipes for leaks.
- Keep a container of drinking water in the refrigerator.
- Do not let water run when you wash, shave, or brush your teeth.
- Reduce showering times.
- Use water-saving devices.
- Use a broom instead of a water hose for cleaning.
- Irrigate at night and with a pail for small jobs.

All agricultural users: keep water usage to a minimum. Irrigate only at night and during non-peak hours, from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Minimize water usage for dust control. Use water wisely.
