FIELD TRIP TO KALOKO-HONOKŌHAU
NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK**

WHAT: Field trip to Kaloko-Honokōhau National Historical Park (Free)

WHEN: Friday, October 14, 2011

TIME: 12:00 noon to 2:00 p.m.

Nā wai ola o Kāne (life-giving waters of the god, Kāne) provides the life-essence in the dry Kekaha district of West Hawaii. Native Hawaiian conservation values protect the use of the land, sky, and sea by laying out specific guidelines for interactions between humans and nature. Kaloko-Honokōhau National Historical Park perpetuates these conservation values and also contains visible reminders, such as *heiau* (temples), three types of *loko i 'a* (fishponds), and *ki 'i pōhaku* (petroglyphs) that speak of the spirit of this place. At Kaloko-Honokōhau National Historical Park, the ancient world surrounds you. Established in 1978, this unit of the National Park Service preserves and perpetuates examples of Hawaiian land and water use in a coastal settlement across sections of four *ahupua 'a*, (traditional land divisions) the largest being Kaloko and Honokōhau. The mission of the park is to preserve, interpret, and perpetuate traditional Hawaiian culture and activities. During your visit, you will see the restored Kaloko Fishpond *kuapā* (sea wall) a 250-yard long dry-stack rock seawall that is 6 1/2 feet high and 30-40 feet long, the only fishpond *kuapā* of its kind in Hawaii; visit some of the many coastal brackish pools that provided life-giving water to early Hawaiians and that are home to rare fauna found nowhere else in the world; observe the endangered Hawaiian stilt and Hawaiian coot as they forage at 'Aimakapā Fishpond; and enjoy watching green sea turtles graze in the shallow waters along Honokōhau beach at 'Ai'ōpio Fishtrap.

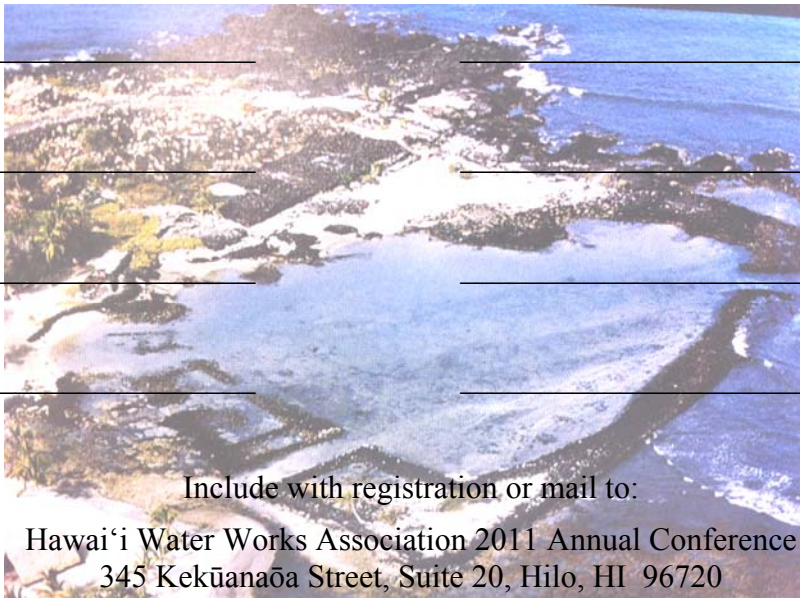
