

COST OF POWER ADJUSTMENT

Effective July 1, 2007 the unit power cost charge on your water bill for consumption is increased from \$1.50 to \$1.60 per thousand gallons. The monthly standby and consumption charges remain unchanged. This adjustment is provided for as part of our annual budget review process, and is based on the annual electrical pumping charges incurred by the Department to deliver water to its customers. For the average residential customer using 20,000 gallons every two months, their bi-monthly water bill will increase by \$2.00, from \$77.00 to \$79.00.
