## **RATE CHANGE: POWER COST CHARGE**

The current Power Cost Charge of \$1.75 per thousand gallons is under consideration for a possible increase to reflect the increase in the Department of Water Supply's power costs through December 2010. The proposed Power Cost Charge will be **at a rate between \$1.75 and \$2.50**. The approved rate will be effective the first day of the month after the establishment of the rate by the Water Board.
