The following revisions and changes shall be made a part of the contract bidding documents:

1. Changes to **PROPOSAL**:

REVISE Page P-4, Part "A", Item 3 to eliminate demolition of the existing gas chlorination system from the description of work. Demolition work to be covered under Part "A", Item 1.

2. **CLARIFICATIONS**:

- a. Photos of the chlorination room access and existing conditions have been attached for bidders' reference.
- b. As-built drawing for the reservoir 12" influent piping and 16" effluent piping has been attached for bidders' reference. At the point of intersection with the proposed trench for new electrical and signal conduits, the depth of the 12" influent piping is approximately 5' below the existing grade, and the depth of the 16" effluent piping is approximately 4.5' below the existing grade, as determined by the as-built drawing. The Contractor shall be required to tone the line and verify depth in the area of work prior to commencing trenching work.

2. If any person is employed in proximity of the facility when an emergency release of chlorine occurs, each employee shall take a precaution that is not... (instructions for safety equipment use, evacuation routes, etc.)
3. Contact the following:
 - a. County Fire Department: 333
 - b. Florida Department of Transportation: Chief of Operations or alternate in charge (use cell or mobile phone number)
 - c. St. Johns County Emergency Control Unit (use cell or mobile phone number)
 - d. St. Johns County Emergency Response Center (use 238)
 - e. St. Johns County Emergency Response Center (use 238)
 - f. St. Johns County Emergency Response Center (use 238)

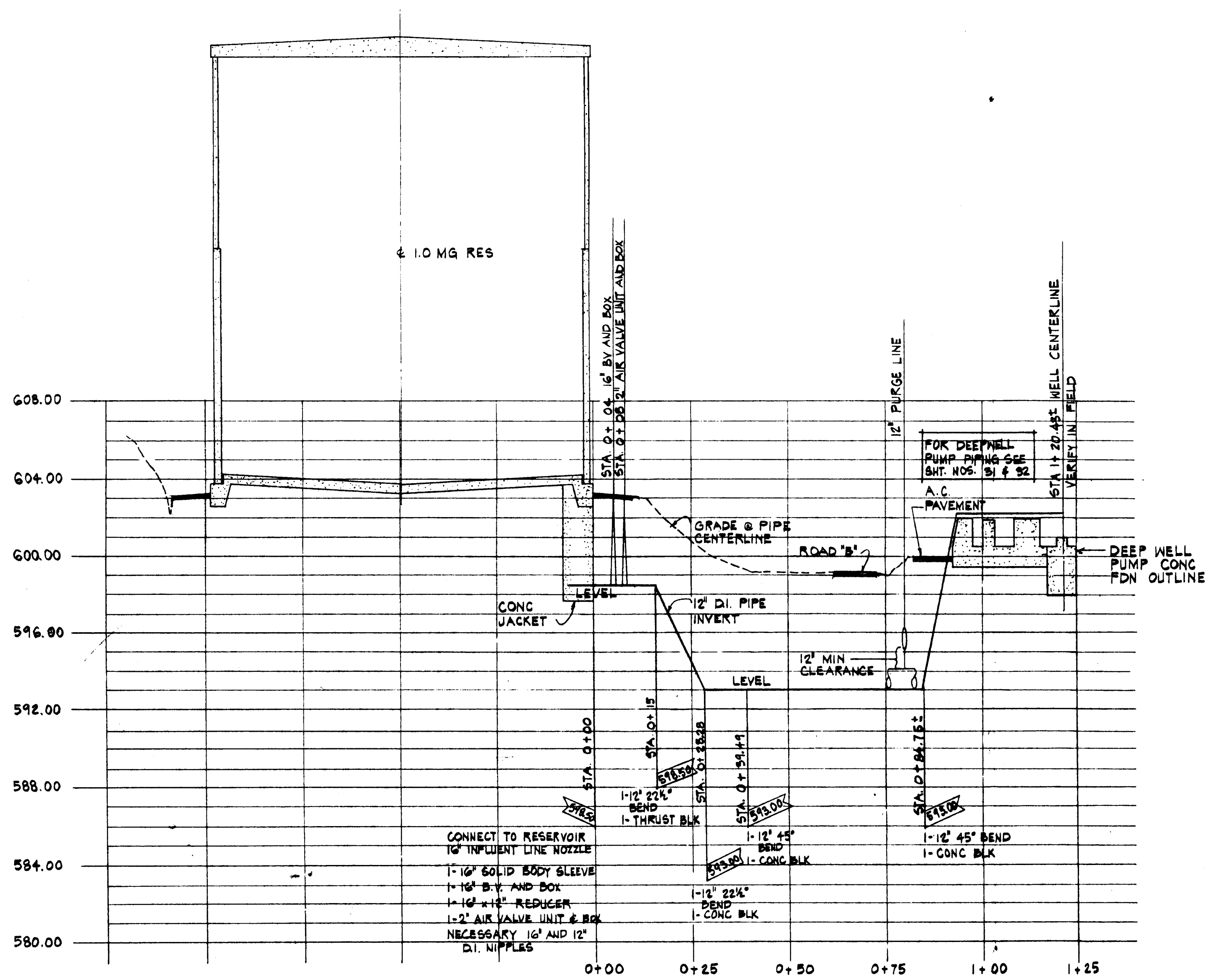






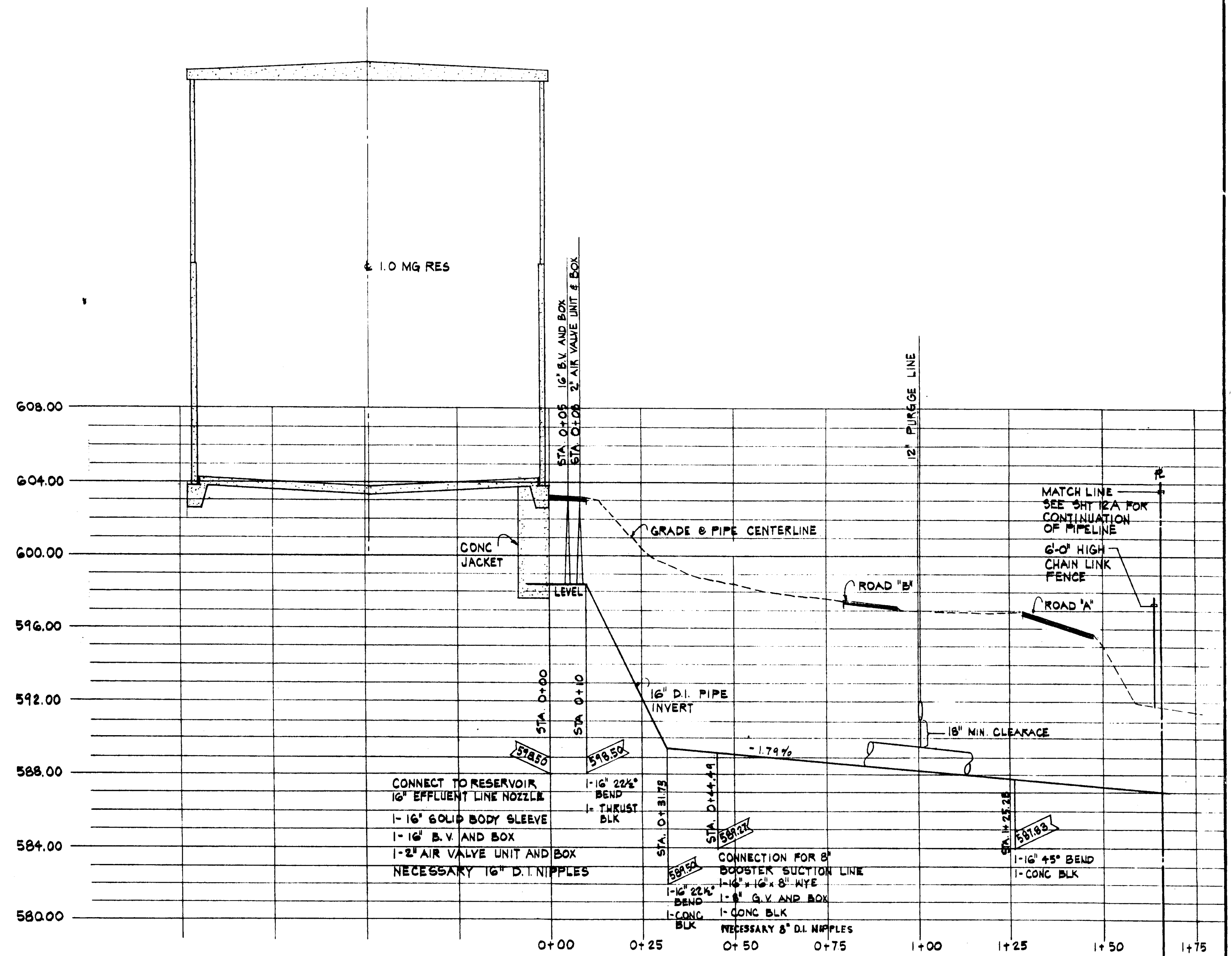






PROFILE ~ 12" INFLUENT LINE
