

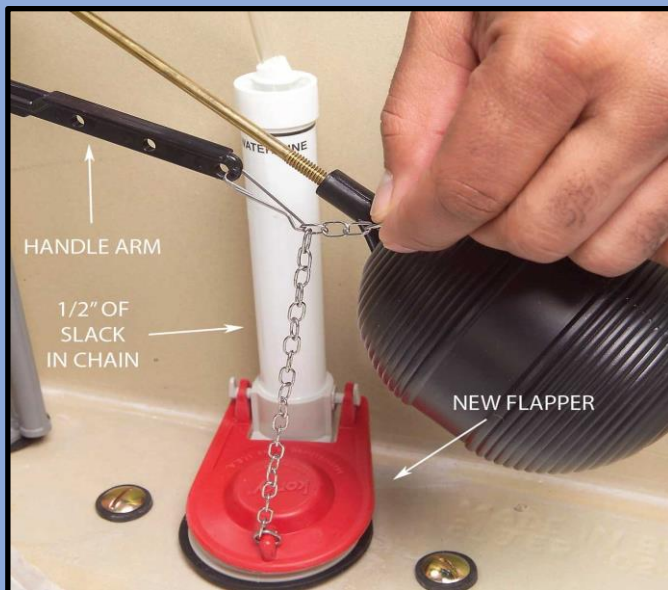

## Replacing Leaky Toilet Flapper

Replacing a leaky toilet flapper is an easy way to save water and money.

A worn-out flapper can cause water loss without you knowing it. New flappers cost about \$10 each and can be installed in a few minutes.

### You will need:

- New flapper
- Small plastic bottle and cap\*

#### Step 1:

Turn the water off using the valve below the tank.

#### Step 2:

Remove the tank cover and flush toilet.

#### Step 3:

Remove the old flapper.

#### Step 4:

Attach new flapper making sure seal is tight.

#### Step 5:

Turn the water on and flush toilet.

#### Step 6:

Replace tank cover.

#### \*Super-Saver Tip:

Fill a small plastic bottle with water, cap, and place in the corner of the tank.
