<u>CHR. HIRAKAMI</u>: I'm Steve Hirakami, Chairman of the Board. At this time, I'd like the secretary to call roll.

The Department of Water Supply is operated and controlled by this Water Board as provided by the Hawai'i County Charter, and as part of Hawai'i Revised Statutes, this Board is allowed to adjust rates up or down so that we be self-sufficient and be able to carry on consistent water distribution on the Island of Hawai'i. With that being said, I didn't see any protestors outside to testify, but do we have any public testifiers?

MS. AVENUE: We have none, Chair.

<u>CHR. HIRAKAMI</u>: We have none. Okay, so we'll be discussing the Power Cost Charge adjustment, but actually it's very favorable because it's going from \$2.70 to \$2.64 per thousand gallons.
