

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
(Chapter 103D, HRS)

SEALED BIDS for **JOB NO. 2023-1219, HAINA BOOSTERS A, B & C REPAIR**, District of Hāmākua, County of Hawai‘i, State of Hawai‘i, will be received ELECTRONICALLY by the Department of Water Supply, County of Hawai‘i, until **April 2, 2026, at 1:30 p.m.** when they will be publicly opened. Bids received after the time fixed for opening or delivered elsewhere other than specified herein will not be considered.

This project generally consists of furnishing all labor, materials, tools and equipment necessary to remove the existing booster assemblies; install Contractor furnished multistage inline booster pumps, C-Frame motors with motor stands, and all appurtenant materials; seal off the existing suction can and install pump mounting stand, inclusive of concrete work; complete an efficiency and vibration test; daily clean-up of the job site at the conclusion of each work day; and perform all incidental work necessary to complete repair in accordance with the specifications.

A pre-bid meeting shall be scheduled for **March 18, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.** at the Department of Water Supply’s Haina Boosters site located at 45-444 Lehua St, Honokaa, HI 96727. Please notify the project engineer, Samuel Adler, (808) 961-8790, by **March 13, 2026, by 3:30 p.m.**, to indicate your attendance. Should no notifications be received, the pre-bid meeting shall be cancelled. Site visits shall be by request only. Contact the project engineer to schedule a visit and for directions.

To be eligible to submit a bid, the Bidder, or subcontractor, must possess a valid State of Hawai‘i C-57a or C-68 Contractor’s license.

Upon registration, forms of specifications, instructions, terms and conditions, and proposal may be obtained from the Office of the Manager-Chief Engineer, through PUBLIC PURCHASE (www.publicpurchase.com), an e-procurement system.

Prospective bidders must file with the Manager-Chief Engineer their "Intent to Bid" no later than ten (10) calendar days prior to the time advertised for opening of bids.


